Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Coralville/North Liberty Forevergreen Road Extension Phase 2 Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Coralville, located at 1512 7th St, Coralville, IA 52241.

The funding for this project would help connect Interstates 80 and 380 by creating a newly constructed road between Naples Avenue and the easterly completed section of Forevergreen Road. The arterial road would include two vehicle travel lanes, a 10' wide off-street multi-use trail on the north side, a storm system, and a water line.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it is an essential piece of transportation infrastructure that will strengthen mobility, safety, economic development, and long-term regional connectivity for the entire metropolitan area. Forevergreen Road serves a rapidly growing area that includes major new medical, educational, and research facilities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
