8 (a) In General.—In fiscal year 2026, for any period

9 during which interim continuing appropriations or full-

- 1 year appropriations for that fiscal year have not been en-
- 2 acted for the Department of Agriculture, there are appro-
- 3 priated to the Secretary of Agriculture, out of any money
- 4 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, such sums as
