Explanation of request:

The City of Winfield is 59.9% low to moderate income and a disadvantaged community whose current WWTF is in the 'significant non-compliance' category. The funding would be used to upgrade the city's wastewater treatment plant to comply with ammonia, E. coli effluent limits and dissolved oxygen limits. In addition to the compliance, improvements are needed to replace failing equipment and increase peak flow capacity at the WWTF's main lift station. The scope of work will include construction of four Submerged Attached Growth Reactors, blower building, upsize lagoon intercell piping, lagoon sludge removal and lift station improvements.
